Strict enforcement of the uniform policy is a high priority. Staff and Parents are asked to;

- Encourage pride in appearance and compliance with the Uniform Policy.
- Acknowledge children who do make an effort, no matter what the level.

Appropriate Jewellery

Appropriate jewellery is a watch and stud earrings. The stud earrings must sit on the ear lobe and not dangle below the ear. If any other items are worn students are to take these items off and placed in their school bag. This will be considered a uniform breach. Please see the uniform breach section below.

Nail Polish

Children are not to wear nail polish to school. This will be considered a uniform breach. Students attending with nail polish will be asked to attend the office where nail polish remover will be applied. Please see the uniform breach section below.

Non-Navy, or Jade hair accessories or inappropriately coloured shoelaces

These are not to be worn at school and will be considered a uniform breach. Please see the uniform breach section below.

Any Non-Uniform Items: shoes, socks, shorts, skirts, blouses, hats, jumpers, tracksuit

pants without an explanatory note from parents.

If you are unable to send your child to school on a particular day in the correct uniform, please inform the teacher in writing.

Hair

Children with hair shoulder length or below, or hair obstructing their face, are asked to have it tied back away from their face. Children are asked not to have non-natural colour hair dyes.

Hats

A “no hat - play in the shade” policy and rule is firmly established at St Joseph’s. Caps of any description are unacceptable headwear.

This school hat is the only acceptable form of headwear.

School Uniforms - Purchase

The uniform is available from *U Design* which is located in the old brewery building in North St. Grafton. We also have a second hand store here at school.

Lost Property

All lost property is stored for the term. Uncollected items are then sent to St Vincent de Paul or to the clothing pool at the back of the canteen.

We ask that all items of clothing be labelled with your child’s name as this greatly reduces the number of lost property items.

Uniform Breaches (from behaviour SOP)

It is the classroom teacher’s responsibility to monitor uniforms. Any member of staff can take the appropriate action and advise the classroom teacher identifying the uniform breach.

The Principal, AP or delegate will inform the classroom teacher of any other arrangements which may be made with families.

Breach levels and consequences

1st breach - A note will also be sent home to advise the parents of what item of clothing was incorrect and the support that the school can provide to alleviate this issue for the student and their family. This note is provided for the classroom teacher.

2nd breach – If a student continues to attend school in the incorrect uniform despite the school’s attempts to support the student and their family, the classroom teacher will send the second and last uniform breach note home.

3rd breach – The principal will request a meeting with the parents to solve the issue.

No student will be able to leave the school grounds for any school outings unless they are in full school uniform.

If it is not possible for a student to wear the correct uniform due to an irregularity, the parents should provide their child’s teacher with a note explaining the inconsistent wearing

of the uniform.
